TO ALL ROOTES GROUP VEHICLE WAREHOUSERS

ANTI-FREEZE PROTECTION

WAREHOUSE VEHICLE STOCK

With effect from October 15th, all cars shipped from the United Kingdom will be treated with Bluecol anti-freeze. This treatment of 50% Bluecol will give nominal protection for vehicles during shipment and storage due to Minus 20°F.

A label will be affixed to the windshields of all cars denoting that Bluecol has been installed and radiators should not be drained.

Addressees attention is brought to the Warehouse Contract Paragraph 2, Section G.

All cars held in stock and handled after October 15, 1963, if not already protected, should be treated with a permanent anti freeze. The requisite amounts for full protection being:-

- 1. All light car range, Husky 1600 Series V and Super Minx 4 Quarts.
- 2. All Sunbeam range 4 Quarts.
- 3. Humber range 6 Quarts.

Due to possible electrolysis action with light alloy attachments to the engine, only a recognized named brand permanent anti-freeze should be used.

Will all addressees acknowledge receipt and understanding of this bulletin and return completed sheet to Wholesale Service office, Long Island City or Los Angeles.
