RETAIL DELIVERY CARD

FEBRUARY 1964

- With effect from March 1st, 1964, the present Guarantee Application Card will be replaced by an IBM Retail Delivery Card.
- For every car shipped to you from March 1st, 1964 onwards, you will receive with your invoice an IBM Retail Delivery Card. This card will quote the serial number and description of the car and also your dealer number.
- 3. Please be sure to complete the necessary details on this card and return it to Rootes Motors Inc. Service Dept. in the envelope provided immediately the car has been sold to your retail customer.
- 4. For those cars which you sell out of your present stock and for which you do not have an IBM Retail Delivery Card, it will be necessary for you to submit the existing Guarantee Application Card, except for these cars please discontinue using the present Guarantee Application Card immediately.
- 5. In the event of a dealer purchasing a new unused car from another dealer it is important that the buying dealer obtain the Retail Delivery Card from the selling dealer. It is important that the buying dealer then change the dealer code number on this card to his own code number.
