SUBJECT: BORG WARN R 35 : OUTER CLUTCH PLATES

A number of cases have arisen where the outer clutch plates have been fitted incorrectly or to the wrong clutch, resulting in an early failure.

On no account must the front clutch outer plates (which are flat) be fitted to the rear clutch (coned plates) or vice versa.

Outer clutch plates may be dentified as follows:-

Front Clutch Outer Plate (Flat)

(U.S.A. origin: vendor's (stamp on one tooth. (U.K. origin: two teeth (removed 180° apart.

Rear Clutch Outer Plate (Coned)

(U.S.A. origin: four teeth (removed; two pairs 1800 (apart. John opigin:)-four (teeth pemoved (900 awart.

LIPORTANT

When installing the coned outer rear clutch, the coning on all plates must face the same direction.
