

SUBJECT: PETROL PIPES FOULING BRAKE PIPES

MODEL: LIGHT CAR RANGE (EXCEPT ALPINE)

It has been brought to our notice that a condition may arise in service where the feed pipe to the petrol pump can possibly foul either one of the two brake pipes leading down the 0/S front wheel arch from the 4-way brake union.

Special care should be taken to ensure that after work on the fuel system, engine etc., there is at least one inch clearence between the petrol and brake pipes. Fig.1 shows the pipe layout on the Light Car Range other than Super Minx, Vogue and Alpine. Fig.2 shows the layout on the current Super Minx and Vogue.



Cars coming into your workshops for servicing should be checked.
